Some fully online courses are offered in an **accelerated** 7-week format. Accelerated courses cover the same content as a 15-week semester at a faster pace.

Want face time *and* online flexibility?

You may want a **hybrid program** that offers a blend of learning opportunities, where you can choose a combination of online and on-campus courses.
